The Parish Council has been successful in several grant applications this year, Cornwall Council CIL grant, Lottery & Tree Council enabling work to take place without having an impact on the Precept (residents' portion of the Council Tax).

The £19,890.09 overspend was taken from CIL received the year before and placed in ear-marked reserves, so there is no impact to the Council Tax.



Chairman's Report 2023-24

2023/2024 was a busy period for the Parish Council seeing many applications and projects throughout. Notable projects include the extension at the Indian Queens Youth Club which was funded by a grant from Cornwall Council and the Community Infrastructure Levy received by the Parish Council. Fencing was erected around the area to make safer as well as new furniture and heating. Extending on from that as a separate project to resurface the car park at the Indian Queens Recreation Ground funded partly by a grant from the National Lottery.

A new Community Orchard project was started at the Strongman's Field which was funded by a grant from the Tree Council. The Parish Council also assisted the Youth Football by purchasing a storage container at the Recreation Ground. A new allotment field was created opposite the Indian Queens Cemetery with an additional 15 allotments for the community with hardstanding parking.

Last to note was the resurfacing project on Church Lane next to St Francis Church to rectify the drainage issues and make the footpath safer with anti-traffic barriers, there is some work still ongoing on this project.

I would like to thank the members of the Parish Council for their work over the last 12 months giving up their time voluntarily. I would also like to thank Cllr Jackie Baker for her 2 years as Chairman as my predecessor. I would also give special mention to Cornwall Cllr Dick Cole for his work in securing a lot of the funding over this period, who has recently hit a milestone of securing over 1 million pounds of funding and grants over his time as Cornwall Cllr for community projects. A thanks also to our hard-working Clerk Amanda who single handedly collates all our administration and mostly the first point of contact for the public.

I would like to take this chance to remind any members of our community to take full advantage of our public sessions at Full Council meetings each month where any points can be made and can be a quicker way to get a direct response to your query from all council members.
