The fees indicated for the various heads of items 1 and 2 do not include the digging of the grave;

**Part 1. EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL**

1. For the exclusive right of burial :-
  - i. For an earthen grave for a child under 18 years FREE .....
  - ii. In an earthen grave 7' 6" by 3'6" in a site taken in rotation £190 .....
  - iii. In an earthen grave 7'6" by 3'6" in a site selected out of rotation £274 .....
2. For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains,
  - i. In a cremation plot 2' by 1'6" in a site taken in rotation £121 .....
  - ii. in a cremation plot 2' by 1'6" in a site selected out of rotation £143 .....

**Part 2. INTERMENTS**

1. For the interment in a grave where an exclusive right of burial has been granted:-
  - i. Child whose age at the time of death is under 18years FREE .....
  - ii. Person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years £168 .....
2. For the interment of cremated remains in a grave/cremation plot where an exclusive right of burial has been granted... £59 .....

**Part 3. MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND INSCRIPTIONS**

For the right to erect on a grave/cremation plot where the exclusive right of burial has been granted:-

1. A headstone, not exceeding 4' in height, 2'6" wide £74 .....
2. Kerb stones, on any grave space, not exceeding 6'6" by 2'6" £74 .....
3. A desk-top memorial, on any cremation plot, not exceeding 2' by 1'6" and 1' high £74 .....

The fees indicated for the various heads of Part 3 include the first inscription.

4. Each additional inscription after the first £32 .....
5. Cemetery Record Search Fees £32 per hour (pro-rata)

These fees were approved by the Burial Authority (Parish Council) at its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2020 to take effect from 1st April 2021 (The Local Authorities' Cemeteries Order 1977)

**The fees apply** - where the person to be interred, or the person to whom the right is granted is, or immediately before death was, an inhabitant or parishioner of the St. Enoder Parish or, in the case of a still-born child where one of the parents is, at the time of interment, such inhabitant or parishioner.

**OR** where the person to be interred, having been a resident of the Parish for 15 years in total or lived the majority of their life in the Parish shall be deemed a Parishioner, the Council will retain the discretion to allow interments to other individuals with significant family connections to the Parish. **In all other cases the fees will be doubled.**
