

INDIAN QUEENS & ST. ENODER CEMETERY MAINTENANCE

Tender contract to commence 1st May 2022 FOR 4 YEARS

Specification

ALL GRASS areas in the cemeteries & Indian Queens Cemetery & St Enoder Cemetery grass verges (at the entrance of the cemeteries) to be cut weekly from March to October and fortnightly from November to February, grass cutting to be removed/mulched.

Grass around headstones, between kerbing, trees, paved areas and seats to be kept tidy by regular trimming.

Old graves on right with kerbing and stones to be sprayed with weed killer as necessary, strimming between kerbing stones.

All grass mowings to be kept off the paths & headstones/ memorial stones, wiping down to remove grass.

ENTRANCE GATE & PATH edges to be kept tidy and weed free.

FLOWER BEDS to be tended and kept tidy at all times. Weeding when necessary to ensure all flower beds are weed free and providing additional plants if necessary.

HEDGES , SHRUBS & TREES to be trimmed & pruned when necessary to keep a tidy appearance. Hedges strimmed and drainage ditch kept clear.

BINS to be emptied weekly at St Enoder Cemetery and daily at Indian Queens Cemetery, rubbish removed from site.

WATER CONTAINER at Indian Queens Cemetery to be topped up when necessary.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE: Gates, Walls & Sheds to be painted when necessary, Parish Council will provide the paint. Ivy cut back on sheds and walls when necessary.
