Chairman's Report 2017-18



At the time of writing my last Chairman's report the UK had just decided to exit the European Union, a year on and we don't seem to have made much progress, who knows what another year will bring.

On the other hand St Enoder Parish Council has been proactive. Once we have made a decision we have pressed on to deliver and we trust you the parishioners can see the results.

For the young parishioners of St. Enoder we are rolling out an improved provision for the youth with the senior youth club meeting two nights a week.

There will also be a community led junior youth club meeting one night a week.

After the successful instalment of the new playground equipment in Indian Queens Recreation Ground, the area has been further developed with the instalment of new metal fencing, additional car parking and CCTV. This year we are seeking to upgrade the playground equipment in the Summercourt Recreation Ground. We have consulted the local residents, including children at the local Summercourt School to come up with a playground to suit everyone. We hope to have the new equipment installed by the time the children break up for the summer holidays. We are thankful for the input and hard work that Councillor Dick Cole and Parish Clerk Amanda Kendall has made into this project. The Landscaping at Fairview Park has now been completed.

The Kelliers is now owned by St Enoder Parish Council. As a result, we are planning to make the area more accessible for the local community, ensuring a public open space, with wildlife countryside, area. The Wesley Pre-school are seeking to run a Forest School. Unfortunately, there is a lot of tidying up needed; to rid the Kelliers of fly tipping that has happened over the years. We are calling on the local community to help with this. We intend to begin the work of cleaning up the Kelliers on Sunday 22nd April and if you would like to join us then please contact the Parish clerk or watch out for information on social media.

We have secured a contractor to undertake the work of installing a Cornish hedge to enable us to incorporate the extra land we purchased into the Indian Queens Cemetery. Hopefully this work can begin once the contractor has completed work on the A30 at Temple. Also we hope to rebuild the boundary wall of St. Enoder Cemetery in the near future.

The work on the Neighbourhood Plan is in progress and will be published in the near future.

The 4th May 2017 marked our local elections and I am pleased to say all resident councillors have been re-elected. Unfortunately owing to work commitments the Chair of Planning has resigned and we will be seeking to fill that vacancy in the near future.

Following the closure of the Post Office at Kingsley Village, we were happy an agreement has been reached with the Post Office to provide an outreach Post Office based at Victory Hall, Indian Queens, on 2 days of the week, Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons. The Parish Council will continue to work for a more secure and permanent location in the redeveloped Kingsley Village. Once again, our thanks go to Councillor Cole and our Parish clerk Amanda Kendall for all their hard work and input into this provision and to Kingsley Developers for covering the cost of hiring the Victory Hall.

As a Parish Council we are always seeking to support local causes with grants. This year is no exception. In particular to those organisations who help the communities we serve.

My thanks go to Parish Clerk Amanda Kendall, Cornwall Councillor Dick Cole, and all the St. Enoder Parish Councillors for their dedication to making St. Enoder a great place to live.
