Chairman's Report 2018-19



I have been honoured to represent St. Enoder Parish Council as their Chairman for last 3 years and whoever is Chair for 2019/2020 will be serving a great Parish Council.

So what has the Parish Council been up to for the last year? During the year we have been providing St. Enoder youth with regular youth club sessions on a Monday and Wednesday, undertaken by Young People Cornwall , there has also been a junior youth club led by local community volunteers.

Unfortunately recently the Monday youth club and the community led Friday junior youth club have ceased due to a lack of volunteers. If you are interested in volunteering then please get in touch with the Parish clerk.

The Thomas Playing Field in Summercourt needed refurbishment and it was planned to be completed by the summer of 2018, this took longer than anticipated, but we are pleased to report that we have now completed the work with new playground equipment and refurbishment of some of the existing equipment. The grand opening of the play equipment was performed by children of Summercourt school on the 14th February 2019. We are thankful for all the hard work put in by Parish Councillor Mark Kessell, Cornwall Councillor Dick Cole and Parish clerk Amanda Kendall.

We have had 2 days of cleaning up at the Kelliers and are planning more in the future, if you are interested in joining us then watch out for information on social media.

The Cornish hedge is now complete in the extension of Indian Queens cemetery and new cremation gardens were created in the existing cemetery with extra landscaping.

Our Neighbourhood Development Plan is almost past all the hurdles of consultations and we hope in the near future to be able to implement all the recommendations you have told us to include.

To coincide with commemorating 100 years since WW1 ended ,the Parish Council embarked on producing a book of remembrance (Trusting Fully Trusting) for the lives of men and women in this Parish who paid the ultimate sacrifice of giving their lives in order to keep us free, new Rolls of Honour were also created for the village Halls & Chapel and the original ones have been placed in Cornwall Records Office. Our thanks go to Councillor Dick Cole and Ann Reynolds for all the hard work in producing the book of remembrance (Trusting Fully Trusting).
