Chairman's Report 2025-26

Another year has passed with everything the same but different. The main change being the Government's rules on planning which has almost removed our ability to have a say over our Parish's future with the NDP housing targets now history.

On the upside we have supported local groups and charities from the Under5s to Indian Queens Band. We have nearly taken over the maintenance and capital of 6 open spaces in the Parish and recently resolved their maintenance by awarding contracts for their upkeep for the next 4 years.

Work on The Kelliars is progressing with additional footpaths and picnic areas planned.

We have used the Burthy Solar Farm funds to install boreholes on both the allotment sites and thanks to Aquasource for their installation.

With regards to water, we have had a major cost with a large water leak costing us thousands in water bills. This has now been resolved by completely renewing the pipe from the meter to the Recreation Ground at Indian Queens.

On the personnel side of the Parish, I welcome Cllr Dick Cole's re-election in May last year, employed a new maintenance man, Terry, to work alongside Nigel, and welcome Jane Roberts and Alan Shaw as Parish Councillors. A thank you goes to leaving members Michael Bunyan, Morgan Pascoe and Mandy Gregory who have retired from the Council.

As with any good ship we need a steady hand and in Amanda we have that in spades, thank you for your hard work and diligence.
